



FOUR SEASONS OF THE TREES








Materials needed: paper, pencil, coloring tools (colored pencils, crayons, or markers)

Directions:

- 3. In each one of the four spaces, show a different season by drawing what that portion of the tree would look like during that time of year.
- 4. The seasons are spring, summer, fall, and winter.
- 5. Think about how the leaves, sky, and ground would look during each season. Include animals, outdoor items like playground equipment, flowers, plants, people, and weather conditions in your drawing as well.
- 6. Lastly, add color to your drawing with your choice of coloring tools. Make sure to fill each space with details and color. Be creative!


